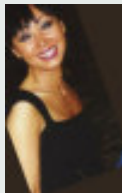

YOUNG CHOON PARK

A child prodigy, South Korean born Young-Choon Park played the Beethoven Piano Concerto No 1 with the Seoul Symphony Orchestra at the age of nine. Since leaving the Juilliard School in New York, she has performed in thirty-two countries in both solo recitals and concertos with many of the world's leading orchestras. She has broadcast on radio and television and is currently recording the complete Mozart Piano Concertos. The Sunday Times describe her playing as demonstrating "real passion and style as well as outstanding technical mastery"

THE ENGLISH ARTS CHORALE

Based in Reigate, The English Arts Chorale was founded by Leslie Olive at St Mary's Church in 1980. Since then it has performed with some of the country's most eminent orchestras, including the Philharmonia, the Royal Philharmonic, the London Moart Players and the English Chamber Orchestra. This autumn, the English Arts Chorale will begin a series of recordings, starting with Brahms' original two-piano version of *Ein Deutsches Requiem*.
