## Elin Pritchard, soprano

Elin is a graduate of the Alexander Gibson Opera School, Royal Conservatoire of Scotland, where she was awarded a Master of Opera with distinction. Her many operatic roles include Tosca for English Touring Opera and Gioielli della Madonna for Opera Holland Park. Elin sings regularly in concert, including with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra and English Chamber Orchestra.



## **Gareth Brynmor John, baritone**

Winner of the Kathleen Ferrier Award, and Royal Academy of Music Patrons' Award, Gareth is part of the Songsmiths, and sings in the London English Song Festival. He made his debut with Welsh National Opera and has sung with the Bach Choir, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra and the BBC National Orchestra of Wales. Gareth has recorded a disc of song entitled 'The Children's Hour'.
